

NEW OUTWELL REGENT FAMILY TENTS TAKE POLE POSITION FOR COMFORT, SAFETY AND STYLE



By popular demand, Scandinavian family camping specialist, Outwell, has introduced a new range of technical cotton family pole tents. The Regent Collection offers three sizes of three-zone Yosemite Lake tents that provide superlative living space to create a country home where you can enjoy your holiday in comfort, safety and style.

Sleeping four, five (pictured left) and six (pictured below right), the Yosemite Lake tents use the superlative Outtex Airtech fabric that maintains a tent's microclimate no matter the weather. Cool in summer and warm in winter, the fabric's breathable nature helps eliminate condensation while providing a high degree of water resistance thanks to cotton's ability to swell when wet to prevent water entry – all characteristics appreciated by discerning campers.

Steel poles are used for strength and durability. Pitching is simplified by the addition of the Outwell Floating Guyline and Easy Pegging Systems, with stability in high winds enhanced by the revolutionary Outwell Wind Stabilizer System. All ensure a correctly pitched Regent tent can withstand a Force 10 storm. Luminous guys can be easily seen in poor conditions and at night to help prevent accidental tripping.

The front 'wet' zone is accessed by the full front opening and acts as a buffer between the enclosed living area and the outdoors. It proves

the perfect place for food preparation and a place to relax and enjoy the close to nature experience while sheltered from the weather.

The living area is accessed by external side doors backed by anti-bug mesh panels, and the dividing Quick & Quiet Access door that also includes large mesh windows (pictured left). Quick & Quiet Inners also make use of magnetic closure for convenient access without the noise of zips disturbing

the peace.



The mesh door panels and large internal door windows aid the superb ventilation that is provided by the huge Rear Ventilation System and cowl-protected side mesh vents. The side vents are positioned to sit at the bottom of the windows to improve views out and air flow.

All windows throughout are tinted against the sun's glare and nosey neighbours – zip-up curtains provide

the ability to fine tune light and privacy. The HookTrack System provides versatile suspension points for lights and small items.

Regent tents feature Ambassador Master Bedrooms, darkened to reduce light for a good night's sleep. Light is further reduced by curtains over the mesh ventilation panels and the change from a light-coloured outer roof panel over the living area to a dark fabric where it sits over the bedroom.

Ambassador bedrooms provide a luxurious amount of space and headroom, allowing easier movement and the opportunity to use furniture such as bedside tables. The provision of a bedroom cable port means the electric hook-up can be used to power home comforts like lights.

Model-dependent optional extras include a Universal Extension to extend living options. Footprint and flat woven carpet provide extra protection, comfort and easy maintenance.

Outwell Wind Stabilizer System –This patented system is a huge and important innovation in tent stability, proven in development and in the field. It creates a direct attachment point between the outer tent, tent pole and peg for reliable security that spreads the strain of gale-force, gusting winds. Wind tested against the Beaufort Scale to storm Force 9.

Outwell Easy Access System with Mesh – Main doors and corresponding mesh panels fold to one side and the groundsheet lies flush to the ground for safe, easy access.

Outwell Easy Pegging System – This is the proven way to ensure the right pegs are used for the right job. Simple, but highly effective, three types of pegs are used to anchor specific areas of the tent.

Outwell Electing Guyline System – A single luminous guyline connects two upper guylines to the peg

Outwell Floating Guyline System – A single luminous guyline connects two upper guylines to the peg reducing the risk of tripping, speeding up pitching time and making tensioning easier.

Luminous guylines – These are highly visible to help prevent tripping. Pre-attached for easy pitching. **Rear Ventilation System** – The latest sleek profile rear ventilation system for enhanced airflow and easy adjustment.

Tinted Windows – Special coating protects against the sun's glare and provides privacy while maintaining great views out.

Outwell Sealed Ground System – The full groundsheet is sealed to the outer to keep out water, draughts and insects.

Quick & Quiet inner doors – Magnetic strips sewn into the leading edge of the inner doors and the inner's central dividing strip allow quick and quiet bedroom entry and exit with the option of zips for a more secure closure when required.

Quick & Quiet Access – The Quick & Quiet magnetic system applied to the dividing wall separating living and front rooms in three-zone tents.

Outwell HookTrack System – Our Outwell HookTrack System is a smart, yet simple innovation designed to deliver safety and convenience that is reliable in function and easy to use. It allows lights to be positioned where needed, routing wires securely out of the way to avoid accidental damage and trip hazards. Plus, our optional Tent Hanging System lines and clips provide a means to suspend lighter items, like cloths, for additional versatility.

Outwell Sleep Comfort Rating – To aid market comparison we quote the number of people that an Outwell bedroom can sleep as stated by the industry standard. However, we also quote our own Sleep Comfort rating to recommend the number of campers that it can sleep comfortably.

Outwell Ambassador Master Bedroom – Campers have long complained that the minimum tent bedroom size of 200cm long x 60cm wide as laid down by the official standard DIN 112-02-01 AA was just too small. While Outwell complied with the standard to assist campers compare products, the brand also acknowledged that more space in the bedroom was needed and for years has suggested, through its Outwell Sleep Comfort icon, a realistic number of campers an inner could accommodate based on 70cm-80cm per person. As part of ongoing evolution, we introduce the Ambassador bedroom featuring a dark finish to reduce light entering the bedroom to ensure a good night's sleep while cable entry brings power to the bedside.
